RULES OF International Art Contest „Twin towns through the eyes of children”

I Objectives of the contest:

1. Developing students' creativity.
2. Shaping sensitivity to beauty and aesthetics.
3. Developing students' imagination and artistic skills.
4. Supporting the processes of European Integration.
5. Education among future generations of young Europeans.
6. Promotion of Skawina and twin towns: Turčianske Teplice, Holešov, Roztoky, Hürth, Thetford, Civitanova Marche and Przemyślany.
7. Promotion of economical - cultural, sight-seeing - touristic potential of the commune of Skawina and the twin towns.
8. Getting to know partners, developing interests and raising awareness of Skawina's twin towns.
9. Enabling young residents of twin towns to get to know attractions of particular towns.
10. Opening up young people to heritage of European culture and history.
11. Integration of young residents of the commune of Skawina and Skawina's twin towns.
12. Shaping patriotic attitudes.
13. Promoting the idea of partnership between town communities.
14. Development of using various art techniques.

II Participants:

The participants of the competition are primary school students aged 6-9 from the commune of Skawina and 7 twin towns, i.e: Turčianske Teplice (Slovakia), Holešov (The Czech Republic), Roztoky (The Czech Republic), Hürth (Germany), Thetford (Great Britain), Civitanova Marche (Italy) and Przemyślany (Ukraine).

III Conditions of participation:

1. Children aged 6-9 from the twin towns of Skawina and the commune of Skawina will perform artistic work (any technique) representing and promoting city/town/commune they are from (e.g tourist attractions, favourite places, monuments, etc.).
2. Artwork has to be done in a flat form. It can have convex elements that are fastened for good. The size of the work is up to participants on the condition that it is not smaller than A4 and not bigger than A3. There must be personally made frame.
3. On the back of the works there needs to be an imprint completed in upper case letters including the following information:
 - a) the name of the country and town,
 - b) Name and surname, age of the author of the work
 - c) the place that inspired the work
 - d) the name, address, phone and e-mail of the school to which the author of the work attends (Attachment nr 1)
4. Each school may send maximum 5 works.
5. The works must be prepared individually.

IV Organizational arrangements

The competition will run parallel in Skawina's twin towns and Skawina itself.

1. Schools from the commune of Skawina and schools representing Skawina's twin towns conduct the competition in a given school. They pre-select and choose the top 5 works and send them directly by post to:

(applies to twin towns).

2. In the case of an intensification of restrictions related to COVID-19 in Skawina and Skawina's twin towns, it is allowed to send scans or photographs of works electronically (via e-mail) to the organizers' e-mail address (Skawina Twinning Association or Primary School in Wielkie Drogi). In the event of an epidemic risk related to COVID-19 prizes will be delivered by organizers to the schools (concerns the communal part of the contest).

V Place of delivery of contest works

The works must be delivered or sent to:

VI Date of the Contest:

The competition ends **September 30, 2021**. (the deadline).
Settlement of the contest (selection of winners) and award ceremony for school pupils from Skawina community will take place during the solemn final at the Primary School in Wielkie Drogi – the organizers will announce the date of the meeting with a separate invitation.

VII The Jury:

The submitted art works will be evaluated by a jury appointed by the organizers. They will take into account: individuality, care, ingenuity, general artistic impression, relation to the topic.

VIII Prizes:

1. The award winners will receive prizes for individual places and diplomas of participations, and their artworks will be displayed at a post-competition exhibition at Primary School in Wielkie Drogi.

The organizers will award prizes separately for the participants in the international part of the competition (Skawina's twin towns) and for participants from the commune of Skawina.

The following prizes will be awarded:

- Prizes in the competition in twin towns (for the participants from Skawina's twin towns) – 1st, 2nd, 3rd place and 7 awards (honorable mentions)

- Prizes in the competition in the commune of Skawina (for the participants from Skawina) - 1st, 2nd, 3rd place and 7 awards (honorable mentions).
A total of 6 main prizes and 14 awards (honorable mentions).
- 2. The award ceremony for pupils from Skawina will take place at Primary School in Wielkie Drogi – the organizers will announce the date of the meeting with a separate invitation.
- 3. In the event of an epidemic risk related to COVID-19 prizes will be delivered by organizers to the schools (concerns the communal part of the contest).
- 4. The award winners from twin towns of Skawina will receive prizes and commemorative diplomas via post.
- 5. Each participant will receive a commemorative diploma.
- 6. The awarded artworks will be presented at the exhibition honoring “Knowledge competition about Skawina’s twin towns, the European Union and the activities of Skawina Twinning Association” which will take place at Primary School in Wielkie Drogi.

IX Final provisions:

The delivery of the art work, on time, that meets the conditions means acceptance of the rules and declaration that the work is the outcome of creative output and that it does not break the rights of the others, and if, despite the appropriate care the derogation occurs, the Organizers of the Contests are free from the responsibility for such a derogation. (Attachement nr 2)

The authors of the art works (in their name their parents/guardians/teachers) allow to a free of charge placement of personal data (in the case of award winners), photos of their works, the works themselves on the post-contest exhibition, on the Organizers’ websites and in the press. (Attachement nr 3)

The organizers reserve the right to retain all submitted works and their subsequent use.

By entering the competition, you agree to processing of personal data for the needs of the organizers and image of the child in promotional materials.

The contest is co-financed from the budget of the Skawina commune.
